

Christian Formation Program-CFP

Parent Volunteer 2011-2012

CFP CATECHIST- Teacher. This opportunity lets you share your faith with the children of the parish. Weekly time commitment is an hour of class time and time needed to prepare a lesson on Monday or Tuesday from 4:45-6:15pm. Child care is available for younger children who are unable to participate in CFP. 18 years of age and above may apply.

CFP ASSISTANT CATECHIST- Assist the catechist in the lesson plan on a weekly basis on Monday or Tuesday late afternoon from 4:45-6:15pm. Be a substitute when the main catechist is unavailable. Child care is available for younger children who are unable to participate in CFP. Six graders and above may apply.

CFP CATECHIST CHILD CARE- Provide child care for catechist children on a weekly basis on Monday or Tuesday late afternoon from 4:45-6:15pm. The more volunteers the lighter the schedule. 18 years of age and above may apply.

CFP SUBSTITUE- Teach children the lesson plan that is already prepared in the absence of the Catechist. This is an on all opportunity for Monday and Tuesday late afternoon from 4:45-6:15pm. Child care is available for younger children who are unable to participate in CFP. 18 years of age and above may apply.

HALLWAY MONITOR- Ensure children are in classrooms and adults that enter the building are addressed. Time commitment of 1 hour, Monday or Tuesday from 5-6pm. The more volunteers, the lighter the schedule will be.

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE OF MATERIALS- Maintenance of supplies, sharpen pencils, clean up craft caddies and prepare materials for the following week. Very flexible time commitment. May be done any day from Wednesday through Friday from 9am-2pm.

CURRICULUM PREPARATION-AUGUST 2011

This opportunity involves assembling materials into folders. All materials are provided.

Family Folders- assembling copied materials into folders

First Communion Folders- assembling copied materials into folders, parent handbook and guide

Reconciliation Folders - assembling copied materials into folders, parent handbook and guide

Time commitment: in the morning, less than an hour

FIRST COMMUNION RETREAT-October 2011

Assist the main facilitator with activities for the children. Materials and instructions are provided This is an evening opportunity.

Time commitment-less than 2 hours

BLESSING CUP MEAL-November 2011

Preparation of tables for Blessing Cup Meal-This opportunity involves setting a place setting for our First communicants and their families. All materials are provided. Preparation is done the morning of the event. There will be two days that families are able to participate.

Time commitment: less than 2 hours.

Evening Facilitators-This opportunity allows volunteers to provide fellowship with our First Communicant families. You will assist families with serving a home cooked meal to their table and being the hostess with the mostest. This is a beautiful event and it is enhanced by your presence.

Time commitment- 2 hours

Cleaning Crew-This opportunity allows you to wrap things and put things back as they once were. Dishes need to be washed and the Parish Hall needs to be cleaned, tables are wiped and dishes are put back.

Time commitment-2 hours

SEDER MEAL-March 2012

Preparation of tables for Seder Meal

This opportunity involves setting a place setting for our FRE families on Monday and Tuesday. All materials are provided. Preparation may be done prior to the event morning or afternoon.

Time commitment: Less than an hour

Food Preparation for Seder Meal

This opportunity involves preparation of celery, roast beef, pita, horseradish, and charoset. The items once prepped are plated and wrapped for the evenings feast. Preparation is done prior to the event morning or afternoon.

Time commitment: Less than an hour

RECONCILIATION ICE CREAM SOCIAL-March 2012

This opportunity involves prepping tables with table covers and balloons on each table prior to the event. Toppings are set on the main table. When the event begins, volunteers will open ice cream cups and keep tables clean. Minimum clean up, primarily throwing away trash and putting items back in the refrigerator.

Time commitment: less than 2 hours

All volunteers will participate in Protecting God's Children workshop and will have a background check done.
